Medical personnel

Every event must have proper medical personnel in attendance.

For Grappling and Sport AMMA

There must be at least 1 medical personnel per competition area. The medical personnel must meet at least one of the following standards:

- □ Medical Doctor.
- □ Certified athletic therapist.
- □ Physiotherapist with a valid first responder certificate.
- □ Emergency Response Nurse.
- □ Certified Paramedic.

For AMMA (Carded and Tournament)

There must be at least 1 licensed physician per competition area.

There must be at least 2 medical personnel per competition area. They must meet at least one of the following standards:

- □ Certified athletic therapist.
- □ Physiotherapist with a valid first responder certificate.
- □ Emergency Response Nurse.
- Certified Paramedic.

All medicals personnel must be in close proximity to the competitors. For an AMMA event the licensed physician will be seated cage side. If the cage side physician cannot be cage side the competition will be halted until the physician can be present.

Medical personnel will provide all necessary first aid equipment.

Pre and post contest medicals

After weighing in all competitors must see the cage side physician to complete their pre contest physical and fill out the competition medical form.

Directly after competing the competitor must see the cage side physician to complete their post contest medical. The physician will follow the medical suspensions policy and any suspensions will be noted on the competitors passport.

Failure to attend the pre or post contest medical can result in suspensions, fines or loss of membership in accordance to the discipline policy. The OGA takes competitors health seriously and there will be zero tolerance for failure to attend medicals.
