

OGA MMA Officials Council **Terms of Reference**

Mandate

The **OGA MMA Officials Council** is responsible for recommending policies and programs that will support the development of AMMA officials. The **OGAOC** will be guided by staff support of the Head Referee/Chair of Referee Commission. This in turn is overseen by the Ontario Grappling Association.

The Council will review the association plans to develop grappling officials and provide input and feedback on the programs and activities provided for Referees by the Organization directly.

Areas of focus for the **OGA Officials Council** will include:

- Referee development
- Development of female referees
- Coach/athlete resource development with regards to educating a referee's job.
- Support the development of officiating

Composition

The **OGA Officials Council** is composed of the organization's elected officers and/or volunteers from various areas across the country. The following constitute the **OGA Officials Council**:

Referee Commission Head - Chair
Official lead (VP)
Draw Master lead
3 Members

Reporting

The **OGA Officials Council** reports to the Organization President/Committee via the Chair. The Committee is a recommending body to the Organization, and, ultimately, the Ownership.

Meetings

The Committee will meet twice per year, the meetings approximately six months apart.

The budget for the meetings will be under the financial control of the Head of the Referee Commission who will liaise with the President/ED of the Organization to arrange the agenda and logistics for the meetings.

Minutes of the meetings will be kept by the Head of Referee Commission and distributed to the Organization Lead/Owners once approved by the Chair of the **OGA Officials Council**.
